

We have updated our policies and procedures to adhere to social distancing guidelines and OHA recommendations. Please read through before arriving for your first lesson.

#### Lesson Information

- Private lessons are a 1:1 (student/teacher) ratio; semi-private lessons are available for siblings.
- Private lessons will be 25 minutes in length. This shortened time will allow instructors to clean and sanitize between classes.

#### Before Class

- **Swimmers must arrive in their swim suit and be ready to get in.**
- No goggles, swimsuits, swim diapers, or towels will be provided. Please bring your own. Goggles, swimsuits and swim diapers will be available for purchase.

#### Arrival

- We have a designated entry point and designated exit door.
- We will start check-in 5 minutes before the start of your child's class. Please do not arrive earlier than 5 minutes before class.
- We will take temperatures for everyone entering the building. Hand sanitizer is available, as well as an on-deck rinse shower and bathroom facility.
- Masks are required for all patrons and children who enter the building. Once the child is on the pool deck, they may remove their mask for swim lessons.

#### During Class

- Only one parent and NO unattended siblings will be allowed in the building. We understand that many families have multiple children. Parents will have the option to drop off at the front door or pool deck and wait in the car.
- No parents will be allowed on deck with the exception of our Parent Child class.

#### Departure

- No locker room area or private showers will be available for changing. We have one shower on deck to rinse off. Swimmers may dry off near the exit and must leave immediately after.
- There is a designated exit door located near the parking lot.

#### Staff & Additional Sanitation

- All staff is required to do a temperature check before the start of their shift. During swim class, instructors will wear a face mask or face shield to protect themselves and your child.
- In addition to regular cleaning and sanitizing, all instructors will clean and sanitize the equipment and toys after each class. Front desk and/or the Deck Supervisor will also perform additional cleaning of doors, chairs and commonly touched surfaces between each class rotation.
